Loveworks are a local food charity with a mission to help improve the lives of local people through food.



During September, we handed out 203 food parcels, feeding 438 people, a slight increase to August.

We usually see an increase in referrals in the winter, so we expect the number of parcels to continue to rise in the coming months.

The cost of the food provided in just one average sized food parcel from Loveworks is £40!
