

APCM - O6th April, 11.30am

The PCC is required to hold an APCM (Annual Parochial Church meeting) at which reports are shared, accounts approved, new members and officers are elected, and questions may be asked about any area of the church's ministry. Anyone may attend the annual eeting and raise questions.

At the APCM each year we have to appoint church wardens and fill any PCC vacancies. Both Tom and Jen are standing to be warden again. If anyone else wishes to stand please speak to Hannah in person or by phone before Thursday 27th March. Nomination forms must be received by Hannah before the end of Saturday March 29th.

Two members of the PCC have completed their first three year term. Both are standing for reelection. In addition we have one Deanery Synod casual vacancy which will be for a one year term. If you wish to stand for election to any of these positions please speak to Hannah for the correct forms. Nominations for PCC and Deanery Synod members can be received at the Annual Parochial Church Meeting (provided there is evidence of acceptance by the nominee).





Join us for fun crafts, activities, fellowship and food for the whole family.


